2. The following information is herewith forwarded:
 - a. Date and Time Observed: 2055 hours, 22 September 1953.
 - b. Location: 2506 Cornell Street, Lawton, Oklahoma
 - c. Observers: Captain John R. Grimes, SFC Louis Zelbst and several unidentified civilians living in the vicinity.
 - d. The object appeared conical in shape and presented a white light outlining the entire object. An exhaust approximately three times the length of the object trailed behind it. The object appeared to fly in a straight line from southeast to northwest.
