on May 1, 1951, an inquiry was received at the Bureau from the Office of the Attorney General, State of California, in a letter dated April 25, 1951, pointing out that Silve M. Newton, FRI #635061, had been eited as an authority for a book entitled "Behind the bers," which was published by one Frank Soully The gist of the book is that the se-called flying superra are munifestations of secret scientific reserve being conducted by the Government.

The letter from the Office of the Attorney General further advised that Siles H. Fewton had an arrest record which was known to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Galifernia and requested the Bureau to furnish the Office of the Atterney General with any additional information other than his arrest record which night be austlable in the Bureau files.

With respect to Mr. E. G. Robinson, who prepared the letter of imquiry from the Office of the Attorney General. State of California, under date of Tune 14 19 1.

Rebinson, a former Special Agent of the Sureau who entered on duty as a Special Agent (A) in Merch of 1984 and resigned on April 23, 1941. His resignation stated that he felt that he had progressed as far as he sould in the Sureau's employ and no deregatory information appears in the file concerning him.

A news item submitted by the San Francisco Office dated December 3, 1930, which appeared in the San Francisco News, reflected that Robinson was to be appointed director of investigation for Atterney General-elect Edmund G. Brown, present Atterney General for the State of California, and that Robinson was formerly connected with the Senate Investigations Committee in Vashington and that prior to that time he was associated with the Truman Committee. ## OBSERVATION:

In view of the fact that it has now come to the attention of the Sureau that Lee Gebouer is identical with Lee Julius Arneld Gebouer, FRI Number 3094424, it is felt that as a matter of cooperation with the California authorities, the Sureau might desire to refer the California authorities to the public record of Gebouer's conviction since that conviction is a matter of public record.

## RECONMENDATION:

If we approve, it is recommended that the attached letter be forwarded to the Office of the Attorney General for the State of California, pointing out that Lee Gebauer, concerning when an inquiry was received, may be identical with Lee Julius Armold Gebauer who was convicted in Federal Court at Tuecon, Arizona, on February 83, 1944.

A current check of the Identiciation Records of the Europu does not reflect an arrest for Leo Julius Armold Gebauer subsequent to 1944.
