There is no astronomical explanation of this incident.

In this investigator's opinion, there is nothing in the evidence offered that is basically contradictory to the hypothesis of a weather balloon. Perhaps ascending currents of warm air over the desert could give the illusion that the object was oscillating.

Statement given by Major J. C. Rice, Test Pilot, Macchi Aeroplani,  
Marco Garibaldi.

On 7 July 1917, at approximately 1010, while running up the Italian air  
the ground I noticed everyone was looking up into the sky. Over to the  
north about 10,000 to 12,000 feet altitude, was an object that I believed  
at first to be a small aeroplane but as it moved across the sky it was  
noticed that it was something very different which I could not identify.  
In the opinion of the men flying with me it was a large kite.  
The object was approximately 100 feet long and 100 feet wide.  
It was a square shape 5 to 10 feet in diameter.
