1. Two glowing blue-green lights. Described as two objects glowing rather than ordinary type of lights. One glow was followed by the second a little to the rear and above. There were no other identifying features, and no sound. The objects traveled a course parallel to the earth's surface until they could no longer be seen.

2. Sighted at 2107 16 July 1952 for approximately 10 seconds.

3. Visually sighted from ground.

4. [REDACTED] Ave. and [REDACTED] St., Phoenix Arizona. Object traveled from 270° to 90° approximately 5 miles north at approximately 1500 feet. Observer reports object traveled approximately 10 miles in 10 seconds.

5. Object was reported by Mr. [REDACTED] Phoenix, Ariz. Mr. [REDACTED] is a bus driver on the City Transit lines, and made this observation at the end of his run in the northwest Phoenix area. He is approximately 38 years of age, wears heavily tinted glasses, and has recently read several publications on "Flying Saucers."

6. Phoenix weather at 2035 and 2135 - clear, 15 plus visibility - wind 330° to 280° at 5 knots.
